ENGINEERS REPORT – Mike Taggart reported that the traffic study was conducted on Woodland Avenue and Summit Avenue resulting in 168 cars on Summit Avenue and 97 cars on Woodland Avenue. Follow-up at the February meeting.

Icing on Second Street due to stormwater discharge from 175 Second Street, Mrs. Klepfer, Mr. John and Mr. Leh have met on site. It is a violation of the property maintenance code for the sump pump to discharge on to the street in such a manner as to cause a public nuisance. The property owner will be notified and the sump pump will be disconnected and the direct flow will be onto his lawn. The Borough will need to monitor what impact this has.

The Borough will have the inlets cleaned this month on Second Street between Perkiomen Avenue and Maple Street.

FIRE COMPANY REPORT – Chief Brasch had no Report. Mr. Keyser has a Fire Prevention Grant opportunity for a smoke detector/ co detector for every residence in the borough. The Borough share would be \$1,500.00.



**RESOLUTION TO ALLOW PARTICIPATION AND
VOTING BY TELECOMMUNICATIONS' DEVICE**

WHEREAS, Act 43 of 2012 amended the Borough Code (Act 581-1966) and also amended 53 PS § 46001, section § 1001 of the Borough Code to allow a council member's participation in a council meeting by telecommunication device;

WHEREAS, council has discretionary powers to adopt a policy to authorize a council member to participate by telecommunication device by speaker phones or computer terminals after a physical quorum has been established in (without the official participating on the device) at the meeting place;

WHEREAS, the council and the public shall be able to hear the comments and the votes of the council member participating by telecommunication device;

WHEREAS, council may only authorize participation by telecommunication device for one or more of the following reasons: illness or disability of the council member; care for the ill or newborn in the member's immediate family; an emergency; and family or business travel;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Council of the Borough of Schwenksville County of Montgomery and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
